Seminarians hard at work: I hope you will notice some improvements in the grounds around Saint Mary Church—Matt, Jim and Deacon Barry have been hard at work trimming, weeding, planting and mulching. Matt did a great job filling some bare spots with flowers.

At Saint Boniface, they are scraping and painting some doors around the property, and Jim will be spending some time organizing and updating some computer files. They all spent a lot of time getting both school buildings ship-shape for the fall.

Deacon Barry, in addition to these odd jobs, has enjoyed the opportunities to provide homilies. Many parishioners have told me they liked his homilies—please be sure to tell him as well.

Restoring saints' statues. I found some statues in storage that used to be on display in Saint Boniface Church, and I would be willing to put them back in church if folks would like that. There are open spaces on either side of the high altar—where the fans are. But they are dinged up and really need some love. That kind of work can be expensive; but perhaps someone in the parish would like to do it as a donation or for minimal cost? Please let me know.

My thought was to get them ready now, so they can be returned by November 1, the Feast of All Saints.

Also, some parishioners repaired the statue of the Infant of Prague, which I am planning to return to Saint Boniface Church by the end of November—I thought I would do it then, so we can bless the image on the Feast of Christ the King.
